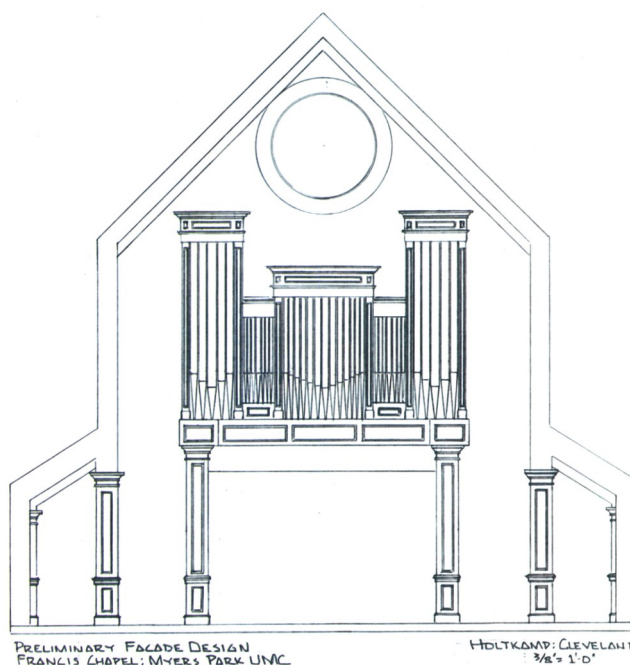

Francis Chapel had always been slated to have a top-notch organ. When our church learned a gentleman in Ashland Kentucky needed to sell the two-year old organ he had built for his home, Director of Music Jimmy Jones and Music Associate Nicolas Haigh drove up, test-played it, and set the deal in motion.

The organ will sound forth at weddings, funerals, preschool worship, and other chapel gatherings. Jimmy envisions organizing chamber music series and other special events for the congregation and community. The organ has 1,000 pipes, the largest being 16 feet tall. By comparison, the Sanctuary organ has 6,000 pipes. The pipes will go on the wall above the entrance to Francis Chapel. You'll be able to walk in, turn around, look up, and be wowed! The console will be located in the front of the chapel.
