SAY

INTEGRITY is more than being honest – it is about being honest no matter what others may think – no matter what anyone will see or hear you being honest.

READ

Daniel's Integrity
Daniel 1

Basic Truth: I can trust God no matter what.

Bottom Line: Be truthful with your whole life.

ASK

- How would you describe Daniel? Why?
- How did Daniel and his friends show integrity?
- When might it be hard to show integrity?
- Who in your life would you describe as having integrity? Why would you describe them that way?
- How did Jesus show integrity?
- What if you were guaranteed you wouldn't get caught if you lied – why would it still be important to choose to be truthful? For example: You drop your mom's phone and the screen shatters. She asks you if you know who did it. What are the consequences of lying? What could happen if you tell the truth?
- What do we mean when we talk about "who somebody is on the inside?"

PRAY

Dear God, you are faithful and you never change! You are the same yesterday, today, and tomorrow. In everything you say and do you are truthful! Your word is truth! And we can trust you no matter what. God, you made each one of us in your image, and we want to reflect you in others. In Jesus' name we pray. Amen!
