Magnifying Glass

Find your bag for October 25, open it, take out the magnifying glass and hold it in your hand.

Say: Use your magnifying glass to look at the ceiling, the floor, the shirt you're wearing, and the back of your hand. What do you notice? Do you see any details you may not have noticed before? Now use the magnifying glass to look at your thumbprint. Can you see each line and curve? When God looks at all He created, he sees it all – the big, the small; every detail. Did you know God knows every hair on your head, every curve of your thumbprint? There is no one exactly like you. Psalm 139, verse 14 says, "I praise you, for I am fearfully and wonderfully made. Wonderful are your works; that I know very well." You are a work of art!

God made us and loves us because we are His creation. That's that! We are His children and we are special and unique. When you make something, it is especially yours. That is how God feels about us. He made us....we are His.

Reflect: Sit in silence. Look at your thumbprint and think of all the ways you are special and unique. What makes you special? What special gifts and talents has God given you? How can you share those with others?

Pray: God, thank you for creating us in your image. We know we are fearfully and wonderfully made. Help us reflect your goodness and creativity and share our wonderful works with others.
