SAY

Today we'll learn that King David was so grateful for what God had done that he couldn't keep silent about it. He was thankful for the way God had helped His people (battles, helping them bring the ark back). Michal was concerned that people would think a certain way about David. For David, it was simple: he danced because he wanted to honor God. He was filled with gratitude to God, and he led the people to celebrate God, too.

Consider ways that you can follow David's example of gratitude and celebration for what God has done in the past and for what He is doing today.

READ

2 Samuel 6:12b-22a **David Dances**

TODAY'S KEY QUESTION - What are creative ways to show gratitude?

TODAY'S BOTTOM LINE - Celebrate what God has done.

ASK

- What's your favorite way to celebrate and worship God?
- If someone said to you, "I don't have anything to be grateful for," what would you say to help them realize that they do?
- Why does God deserve to be celebrated every day?

Dear God, You are worthy of our greatest expression of gratitude and our most joyful celebration. We praise You for what You have done in the past and look forward to all You will do in the future.
