| ___ 2. | Which queen had a "heavenly" name? | B. | That honor probably goes to King Solomon. Besides his other great achievements, he wrote over a thousand songs. (1 Kings 4:32) |
| ___ 3. | How many wives did King Solomon have? | C. | After David had gathered all the material to build the Temple of the Lord, God told him he could not because he had killed too many men in battle. David's son, Solomon, a man of peace, built the Temple. (2 Chronicles 22:2-10) |
| ___ 4. | Who was named after David? | D. | They were mighty warriors - archers who could shoot arrows and sling stones with either the right hand or the left. (1 Chronicles 12:2) |
| ___ 5. | Who was the greatest songwriter in the Bible? | E. | David was known as the "sweet singer of Israel" He wrote 73 of the psalms in the Bible, and one time hired 4,000 musicians to play in praise of the Lord on instruments he had made himself! (1 Chronicles 23:5) |
